1. Port Klang Authority with the cooperation of the port and shipping communities strive to maintain and keep the port waters of Port Klang free of any pollution. With the steady increase in bunkering activities within the port waters, the Port Authority in collaboration with the Terminal Operators have adopted several measures to ensure that bunkering operations are conducted in a safe and efficient manner so as to minimise the risk of accidents and pollution.

2. Effective 1 June 2008, all bunker vessels and bunker receiving vessels are required to comply with the following measures:

i. Initial / Annual Inspection of Bunker Vessels Operating in Port Klang

All bunker vessels scheduled to operate in Port Klang will undergo an inspection prior to commencement of service in the port. In addition annual inspections will be carried out if the vessel continues to be in service in the port. The inspections will be conducted jointly by representatives from the Port Authority and Terminal Operators. Vessels that fail to meet the required standards will not be permitted to operate in the port. Applications for initial / annual inspections shall be forwarded to the Marine Operations Manager, Port Klang Authority. (Please refer to Appendix 1).

ii. Safety Checklist For Bunkering Operations

All bunker vessels and vessels receiving bunkers shall jointly conduct a safety checklist prior to commencing bunker operations. (Please refer to Appendix II). A copy of the checklist duly signed by the Master or authorised personnel from both vessels shall be submitted to the respective terminal operators after completion of the bunkering operations prior to departure. A copy of the checklist shall also be retained by the Master or authorised personnel on board the bunker vessel.
