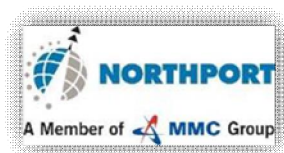


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PORT KLANG GREEN PORT POLICY

PURPOSE: To establish a policy for the integration of overarching environmental sustainability principles and initiatives to guide business decisions, development and operations within Port Klang.

POLICY STATEMENT: The Port Authority is dedicated to protecting and improving the environmental conditions of Port Klang and its surrounding area. Additionally, the Port Authority is committed to conducting operations and managing resources in an environmentally sensitive and responsible manner. To that end, the Port Authority has created this Green Port Policy, which is focused on incorporating a balance of environmental, social and economic concerns into operations in Port Klang. For the purposes of this Policy, environmental sustainability is defined as the ability to meet the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs. It is commonly measured in terms of environmental stewardship, social responsibility and economic prosperity. The following mission and objectives have been developed to guide business decisions in adherence to the Green Port Policy.

MISSION: Provide leadership by minimizing environmental impacts from port development and operations within the port area and ensure a thriving community where people and the environment prosper.

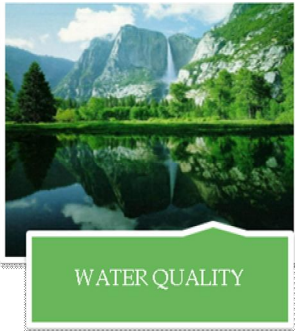
PORT KLANG GREEN PORT POLICY – GOVERNING PRINCIPLE

The POLICY’S ten guiding principles are:

- 1) To minimize to the extent practicable, environmental impacts directly attributable to operations on Port Klang and surrounding areas.
- 2) To strengthen Port Klang’s financial position by maximizing the long-term benefits of energy and resource conservation.
- 3) To prevent pollution, eliminate the use of harmful substances, reduce the impact of climate change and improve personal, community and environmental well-being.
- 4) To confirm applicable environmental laws, regulations and other industry standards in furtherance of the environmental policy.
- 5) To ensure a balance of environmental, social and economic concerns during planning, development and operational decisions.
- 6) To define and establish performance-driven environmental sustainability objectives, targets and programs.
- 7) To monitor key environmental indicators and consistently improve performance.
- 8) To encourage positive impacts beyond economic benefits to the surrounding community;
- 9) To engage and communicate with the community; and
- 10) To conserve natural resources, adopt energy conservation measures and promote the use of renewable energy.

PORT KLANG GREEN PORT POLICY – PRIORITY ELEMENTS

The Green Port Policy includes seven elements, each with an overall goal and objectives:-



PORT KLANG GREEN PORT POLICY - GOAL

The Green Port Policy overall goals:

i. Air Quality

To reduce Greenhouse gas emissions and other air harmful air emissions from port operations.

ii. Water Quality

To improve water quality in terminal and surrounding areas and reduce the Port's water usage to preserve water supply.

iii. Resource Management

To conserve energy and maximize energy efficiency of Port operations.

iv. Waste Management

To reduce waste from port operations through material reuse, recycling and composting.

v. Environmental Management

To promote economic, social and cultural progress through an environmentally sound and sustainable development within port area.

vi. Community Engagement

To interact with and educate the community regarding port operations and environmental programs.

vii. Promote Sustainable Business

To give equal weight to environmental, economic and social concerns in the decision-making process.
