Dear Members,

RE: Clearance of non-essential goods from designated ports

We are pleased to inform that YB Datuk Seri Ir. Dr. Wee Ka Siong, Minister of Transport, Malaysia has just announced that non-essential goods already landed into Port Klang, Penang Port, Port of Tanjung Pelepas and Johor Port can be cleared from the Ports, beginning from this Friday 27/03/2020 to Sunday 29/03/2020.

Please refer to the Media Statement by YB Minister which are attached for your information.

This include FCL, LCL and conventional cargo.

The cargoes can be cleared from the port and warehouses in the Port to their final destinations or to warehouses outside the Ports, to reduce the stress on storage capacity in the ports.

The Ports will develop and implement an action plan to facilitate the delivery of goods from the port on a 24 hour basis.

Police have also been informed to allow the transport of non-essential goods during this 3 day period. Transporters are to abide by the conditions set by MKN.

Export activity will also be allowed to continue as usual and not subject to the Friday to Sunday limitation to ensure that overseas Customers received their goods.

Export of goods will be allowed as long as exporters can show proof that they have contracts to fulfill.

Members are advised to liaise with their customers to be ready to receive the goods at their premises or in members' warehouses.

We thank the Ministry of Transport for their understanding of the concerns of the importers and logistics services providers in coming out with this pragmatic and practical initiative.
