### MOVEMENT OF CARGOES IN AND OUT OF PORT KLANG DURING THE COVID-19 OUTBREAK MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER (MCO) PERIOD (18 MARCH 2020 – 14 APRIL 2020)

The above subject is duly referred.


2. The Malaysian Government has implemented the Movement Control Order (MCO) nationwide to curb the spread of COVID-19 outbreak throughout the country. The MCO which was effective 18 March 2020 to 31 March 2020 has now been extended to 14 April 2020.
3. As an essential service provider, Port Klang is exempted by the order and continues to operate uninterrupted. However the MCO only permits the movement of essential goods and as such only these goods may be cleared from the port for delivery to consignees or delivered to the port for export.
4. In view of this, Port Klang Authority seeks the cooperation of local Consignees / Shipping Agents / Forwarding Agents to inform Principals and Shippers that the restrictions imposed by the Malaysian Government on the movement of non-essential cargoes may result in such imported goods being detained in the port until the MCO is retracted. Therefore delaying import shipments will go a long way in enabling the port to operate at an optimum level without congestion.
5. However, we acknowledge that some shipments may already be in transit and therefore the port will endeavor to accept and store them within the port area. We are also engaging the Ministry of Transport to pursue other avenues to enable cargoes to be delivered to consignees and will keep all parties updated.

6. During these difficult period, PKA seeks the consideration and cooperation of all parties to ensure that the safety and well-being of all personnel in the logistics industry and the general public are given utmost priority while we continue to work together to sustain the economy.
